Housing and Meals-

Most of our meeting attendees stay in campus dorms. This carries on a long-standing tradition and allows for more time spent at the conference together. Meals are included for those staying on campus: breakfast and lunch every day, dinner Thursday and Friday are in the cafeteria. Wednesday and Saturday dinners are buffet meals at a location on campus.

We do reserve a block of rooms at a local hotel for those who do not wish to stay in the dorm. If you are staying at the hotel, you can purchase a commuter meal plan.

Request for Participation –

Those accepted to present in response to our RFP benefit from a reduced registration rate. Unfortunately, we do not have the resources to provide support for implementation of projects at individual campuses. There is no expectation that projects will continue throughout the year or be reported on the following year. This is an opportunity to work on ideas in a collegial, supportive environment and receive feedback. We are happy to provide documentation you may need to get reimbursement from your university.

Virtual Attendance-

This year, attending the conference virtually is still an option. Those who choose not to attend in person will be able to participate in both plenaries, the Memorial Service and Town Hall meeting via livestream. They may also join a morning session via zoom.
